### Spenser's Spot

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails." 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 is read in many weddings every year. It is a great passage to help guide the love in a marriage. However, when we look to Mark 12 it says, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."

The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these." We are to love not only the Lord but our neighbors as well. We tend to go off track here a bit. In my life, I know there are many times where I get frustrated by things and I lose sight of that commandment to love my neighbor.
