### Spenser's Spot

"Be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts. And give thanks for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." Ephesians 5:18b-20 NLT.

Worship is one the more controversial and debated topics in churches all over the world. One of the reasons that I believe this is the case is because it can be a broad term. That's why I love this passage in Ephesians. Call for the Holy Spirit to be a part of worship. Worship should always be filled with the Holy Spirit. Sing Psalms. Often Psalms are linked with the style and focus of modern worship songs that tend to emphasize our emotions and relationship with God. Sing Hymns. Hymns have a history starting with the Greeks and referring to honoring their gods. It was adopted by the Christian Church and during reformation, took on a strictly scriptural basis. It was adjusted even more so as congregational singing changed and became what it is in hymnals today. Spiritual songs tend to be connected more to free, spirit-moved singing sometimes with the focus of relationship and sometimes on God's word. Make music to the Lord in your hearts. The passage says basically, there are a lot of different types of songs that are worshipful. But no matter which category it is or whether it is your favorite of the three, we should be worshipping the Lord in our hearts. Thank the Lord for everything. There are too many negative things in the world for us to get wrapped up in our own preferences. We should thank the Lord for the blessing to be able to gather together freely and sing praises to Him. There's a place for psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs in worship. But when we gather, let us focus on making music to the Lord in our hearts.
